The SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500® REGIONAL – Florida sees a veteran competitor shine in Orlando.

ORLANDO, FL—As the sun rose over A1 Blocks facility October 3rd 2013, competitors in the east parking lot stood patiently by their cars awaiting the start of the Florida Regional SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500® competition. The sun quickly baked the concrete floor of the competition setting the tone that everyone would have to compete in sweltering heat and a steady pace would be the key to victory in the balmy Florida weather. Two men emerge from the crowd; eyes focused holding a guitar case looking over the stalls. Normally this would be an unusual carrying case for a mason. Holding the guitar case is the three-time Florida regional champion and 2010 national champion Ray Robinson. Given his skill set, most masons in Florida were intimidated to enter the SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500 regional competition once they knew he was competing. However, two of the most respected masonry companies in Florida, renowned for their skill and craftsmanship answered the call, Pascal Robertson Masonry and Richard Souder Masonry of Central Florida. Both companies are well known for having some of the best masons in the state and both were ready, willing and able to unseat the champ.

As the competitors began their starter courses, the mood lightened. Classic rock filled the air as fans piled out of cars one by one filling the venue. Food trucks featuring Orlando's finest local fare lined the event along with tents from array of sponsors showing off the latest new masonry industry products, each holding raffles and giving away prizes to fans. Of special interest was the latest in concrete block manufacture, the "A-Block" and "H-Block". These masonry units were developed specifically to keep masons from having to lift standard concrete block over rebar in grouted masonry walls. The labor savings, increased production and reduction in lost time injuries promoted by the use of these innovative

masonry units is industry changing. Anchoring the event was the MCAA and MAF tent where the organizations met with local contractors to discuss the masonry industry.

After forty-five minutes, three bricklayers emerged from the pack. Former national champion Ray Robinson, Pascal Robinson and Rick Souder started to pull away. It could come down to a single brick if the three bricklayers pace continues at this rate. The energy at A1 Block becomes electric as the competitors entered the last five minutes. As the crowd roared Ray Robinson gained a clear lead in the end, but with possible deductions speed does not guarantee a victory.
