# SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500® REGIONAL – WISCONSIN Qualifier promotes masonry in Milwaukee!

MILWAUKEE, WI— An overcast and cool morning didn't keep things from heating up at the 11<sup>th</sup> annual Wisconsin 2013 SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500<sup>®</sup> Regional competition held on September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. This year's event had a full field of 8 mason competitors vying for a trip to Las Vegas at the 2014 World of Concrete/World of Masonry to be held on Wednesday January 22, 2014. This year's Wisconsin mason competitors included 2 past national qualifiers, 4 returning regional competitors, and 2 new rookies trying to upstage the veterans and prove they have what it takes to take the "World's Best Bricklayer," title.

SPEC MIX distributor, The Brickyard, was more than happy to host the regional qualifier this year as it returned to Milwaukee. Our hosts at The Brickyard also brought in some of their trade vendors to show off their products as well. Paul Zvolena took 3<sup>rd</sup> place with an adjusted brick total of 365 while being tended by his brother, Dan Zvolena. The top 2 spots on the leader board were occupied by Nick and Jake Brock. Nick Brock, Exteriors Plus, took home honors of being Wisconsin's Best bricklayer with an adjusted total of 474 brick, and a 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive trip to the SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500 in Las Vegas. Jake Brock, Brock Construction, was not to be outdone by his brother. Jake took home honors as the top Craftsman and second place finisher in this year's Wisconsin SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500.

Established to showcase the skill and craftsmanship of masonry, the general description of the bricklaying competition is as follows: The contest requires all masons to meet the quality standards of the event. They have 60 minutes to complete their 26 foot 8 inch, double wythe brick wall. The competition has four awards; 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place are based on the highest net brick count meeting the quality standards. The 4th award, and arguably considered the most coveted price, the SPEC MIX TOP CRAFTSMAN is judged the most sellable wall. The walls are closely evaluated by carefully selected masonry officials carrying several years of bricklaying experience. Many of the competitors feel winning the SPEC MIX TOP CRAFTSMAN award is their main goal, and it has the second highest award purse.
